Our mixed paper bin handles many of the items you would find in junk mail.

Note: We do not accept bubble envelopes in mixed paper, however, plastic shipping envelopes can be placed in the film plastic area now.

MIXED PAPER EXMPLES

- computer paper
- letter head & office paper
- window envelopes
- notebook paper
- newspaper inserts/junk mail
- file stock
- paper flyers
- office folders
- colored paper & file stock
- catalogs
- phone books

Mixed Paper is made up of paper items and boxboard (cereal boxes) –

NO corrugated cardboard, newsprint or brown bags/paper

Magazines are recycled with Newsprint Paper (all other handbills are put in mixed paper –

NO brown paper (packing or bags)
