## Program Overview

Cornerspring Montessori School (CMS) is committed to our Waldo County community by offering care for our school families, health care providers, and first responders during the current health care crisis.

### Children to be served:

- 2 – 12 years old
- Healthy and symptom free
- 1<sup>st</sup> priority: Currently enrolled CMS students
- 2<sup>nd</sup> priority: Siblings of current CMS students
- 3<sup>rd</sup> priority: Children and dependents of employees of Waldo County General Hospital, City of Belfast, Tall Pines, and other critical health care system organizations
- 4<sup>th</sup> priority: Other community members

### Program provided:

- Groups of 10 or fewer children in multi-age groupings
- Focus on nature-based and outdoor education
- Clean, safe indoor environment
- Breakfast and lunch provided through RSU 71
- Careful attention to health care protocol by all participants
- Daily health assessment of all participants by public health professional

### Scheduling:

- Monday through Friday, **7:30 am to 5:30 pm**

### Costs:

For current Cornerspring students, current tuition expense.

For families new to Cornerspring:

- 8:30 to 3 pm - \$50 per day
- 7:30 – 5:30 pm - \$60 per day
